## **Undergraduate Student Scholarships**

Department of Exercise Sciences Information and Application

#### I GENERAL INFORMATION

Because of generous friends and donors to the department, the Department of Exercise
 Sciences is pleased to make available three scholarships to students. All three scholarships pay
 half-tuition for Fall and/or Winter semesters for one academic year. Students can apply for all of
 the scholarships listed below for which they qualify but will only receive one scholarship for a
 given semester. Students can reapply for a scholarship the following year (up to three years).
 Generally, department scholarships will not be awarded to students who receive other
 university or college scholarships for the same semester(s).

#### **II** QUALIFICATIONS

Minimum requirements for all three of the scholarships include:

- You must be a continuing undergraduate student at Brigham Young University (Provo) in good standing with a declared Exercise Sciences, Athletic Training or Exercise and Wellness major.
- To be considered for a department scholarship, you must apply for a university scholarship and college scholarship. Applications for these scholarships are available online at the College of Life Sciences Scholarship web page (https://lifesciences.byu.edu/lsa/scholarships). Your application will first be reviewed for your eligibility for a university-level scholarship. Your application will then be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee within the College of Life Sciences for eligibility for a college-level scholarship. Finally, your application will be reviewed by the department for eligibility for the three scholarships listed below.

Specific Scholarship Requirements

Charles J. Hart Memorial Scholarship requires applicants to have completed at least 60 credit hours of coursework (but not more than 140 credit hours) at the time of application. The recipient must maintain a course load of at least 12 credit hours in each semester (Fall and Winter) supported by the scholarship.

**Douglas C. and Joy W. Heiner Scholarship** is available to students who will be applying for entrance into an M.D. program. Applicants are required to have completed at least 45 credit hours of coursework (but not more than 140 credit hours) at the time of application. The recipient must maintain a course load of at least 15 credit hours in each semester (Fall and Winter) supported by the scholarship and an overall GPA of at least 3.5.

Garth and Geraldine R. Fisher Scholarship requires applicants to have an overall GPA of at least 3.0.

#### **III** APPLICATION PROCESS - INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Complete and submit your online application for a university scholarship on or before the deadline. Your application will automatically be reviewed by the college after it has been reviewed by the university. If you apply for a department scholarship, your application will then be reviewed by the department. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 2. Fill in the requested information on the next page. When done, print a copy and turn it in to the secretaries in the Department of EXSC in 106 SFH. Ask that it be given to Dr. Pat Vehrs.
