DIETETIC ASSISTANT

Entry Level: Associate's Degree

Dietetic Assistants work under the supervision of a dietitian to gather nutritional data, assess patients' nutritional needs, and prepare menus.²

JOB REQUIREMENTS

What is the exact job title?

- Dietetic Assistant
- Dietetic Technician

How do I become one?

- Complete an associate's degree program (some schools offer a 2-year dietetics technician program).¹
- Complete an internship (recommended) these hours can be applied to the required 450 hours
 of supervised experience necessary to earn the designation of Dietetic Technician, Registered
 (DTR).¹
- Check licensure requirements for your state. Licensure regulations vary by state and job duties/title; registration is voluntary.¹

What qualities do I need?

• Dietetic assistance is a career that works closely with a team and with patients or clients to provide good health through the management of nutrition and diet. Good communication skills and interpersonal relationship skills are helpful to be a successful dietetic assistant. Skills in time and resource management are also helpful.¹

TYPICAL WORK DAY

What do they do?

• Dietetic technicians assist in the provision of food service and nutritional programs, under the supervision of a dietitian. They may plan and produce meals based on established guidelines, teach principles of food and nutrition, or counsel individuals.²

Where do they normally work?

 A dietetic assistant usually works in a hospital setting, but may also be employed in other institutional food service environments.¹

What hours do they work?

Most work a typical 40-hour week.⁴
